#### Late Entries, Changes, Withdrawal and Refund

Late submissions received after 13<sup>th</sup> March 2020 will incur a fee of an additional 50%, bringing the fee payable to \$180 SGD (Individual) and \$120 SGD (Team). We also reserve the right to reject gymnasts and teams who submit late.

All withdrawals by 13<sup>th</sup> April 2020, supported by a medical certificate, will be entitled to a refund of 50% of the fee paid.

There will be a \$30 SGD administrative charge for each name change, for each level/division/group changes after 28<sup>th</sup> February 2020 to 13<sup>th</sup> April. No changes allowed after 13<sup>th</sup> of April 2020. Please check your entry form before submission.

Please inform us on any withdrawals before the competition.

#### **Competition Rules**

- 1. To ensure fairness, the Head Judge will have the right to move any gymnast found competing in the wrong division. Gymnasts can move up a level but will not be permitted to compete at a lower level than they have competed in previously. If a gymnast has been placed for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> AA in our last Invitational 2019, the gymnast MUST move up to the next level except for WAG Levels 9 &10 and MAG/WAG FIG. No award will be given to gymnasts caught flouting this rule.
- 2. There will no event Finals for all levels for both MAG/WAG.
- 3. When a club has entered a minimum of 3 gymnasts per level, they are required to form a team for that level.
- 4. Each gymnast will be issued with a score card to be handed up at the judges' tables when they line up before each apparatus. The coach may collect the team's score card for the next apparatus. Please note that the score card may not always be accurate as adjustments may be made after when judges notice any mistakes in calculations, the score on the BTS is the final score.
- 5. Two (2) coaches per team will be permitted on the competition floor, accreditation passes must be worn at all times. Persons not showing accreditation passes will be asked to leave the competition floor or the Hospitality Room. Coaches must wear club attire on the competition floor.
- 6. All gymnasts must complete an indemnity form. Prime Gymnastics Club takes no responsibility for any accident or injury incurred during (or as a result of) the event. You may email a scan copy in advance or hand it up on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> May at the briefing.
- 7. We will liaise with all clubs through <u>a single point of contact</u>. Please ensure that the single point of contact personnel updates the rest of the team.
- 8. We will have 2 orientation meetings for Coaches, Judges and officials. The 1<sup>st</sup> is on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> May, 7pm and the 2<sup>nd</sup> is on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May, 11am. You are required to attend one of the 2 sessions. We will be handling out the welcome pack with accreditations/Certs/t-shirts.

#### **WAG**

- 1. Floor music must be presented (in **USB** format) to the competition organisers during the Orientation meeting on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> or Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November. <u>Please have the gymnast name/level/club clearly stated in the USB.</u>
- 2. Floor music for compulsory levels 3-5 will be provided by Prime.
- 3. Floor music is a requirement for WAG Level 6 and above.
- 4. Minimum number of 3 entries per level from a minimum of 2 clubs is required to open the level.
- 5. We adhere to all Singapore judging rules (No bonus for levels 3-10).
- 6. We will allow 10cm mats on floor and additional 10cm mat for Vault/Bar/Beam dismounts if required with no deductions for MAG/WAG.
- 7. WAG Level 6-10 gymnasts are to perform 2 Same/Different vaults, higher score to count.

#### **MAG**

MAG Junior FIG and MAG Senior FIG may be combined if the minimum number of 5 entries per level is not received.

#### **Judging**

When a club enters at least 3 gymnasts, they are required to provide one judge. Each judge must be able to commit to **minimum of 3 sessions**, or they can provide **2 judges for 2 sessions each.** 

Please complete the judging form to fulfill this requirement and indicate certification. There will be a judging session conducted by Singapore Gymnastics team before the briefing on Thursday for certified overseas judges.

Clubs who are unable to provide a judge will be required to pay a penalty of **\$250 SGD**. We appreciate your understanding to this rule. We aim for this to be a friendly competition for all our competitors, coaches, officials and parents. Judges hold a key role in ensuring this is possible.

Judges will have a pre-competition briefing, 15 minutes prior to the start of each session

#### Teams

The highest three (3) scores on apparatus will count towards the Team's total score.

Minimum number of gymnasts per team: 3
Maximum number of gymnasts per level: 10

Teams must be made up of gymnasts from the same level.

Clubs may enter up to 10 gymnasts at each level regardless of age categories. Min 3 teams to have a Team Award.

Please use the excel spreadsheet to complete your entries. All age categories will be calculated for you. We hope this will ease any confusion of age categories and the number of gymnasts per team.

#### **General Warm-Up**

Gymnasts are not permitted on any apparatus other than the designated warm up floor area during general warm up.

Gymnasts found on the equipment will be asked to leave the arena and not permitted to compete.

#### **Apparatus Warm -Up**

Specific apparatus warm-up information will be provided at the orientation meeting.

#### **Competition Rotations**

Gymnasts must remain at the designated apparatus waiting area. Teams must move to the next apparatus in line when directed by a competition official.

#### March In

The gymnasts will be assembled at the assembly area as directed by the Marshall prior to march in. Clubs/schools are to ensure that the gymnasts are at the assembly area 10 minutes prior to march in. Clubs are encouraged to bring their club banner to be displayed at the arena

#### We are using the FIG rules to break ties.

All gymnasts will receive a participation medal.

#### **Club Championship**

Entry to the Club Championships is free of charge and automatic for those clubs that have 5 gymnasts competing in different levels or age groups. Scores from the same level but different age groups will be allowed and included. The top 5 all around scores will be added together to make the Club's Team Championship score. MAG AA scores will be on the weightage of 4/6 to match WAG AA scores of 4/4. This award will be presented on the last award ceremony on Sunday.

#### **Presentation**

Presentations will take place following the competition session. Please ensure that your gymnasts are present at least 5 minutes prior to presentation.

#### Hospitality

Refreshments and lunch will be available for judges, coaches and officials in our Hospitality area. We pride ourselves in looking after our guest. Please complete the 'Delegation form' to ensure we have sufficient food.

Only persons wearing official Prime International Invitational Accreditation passes will be allowed to enter this area. Food is to be consumed in the hospitality room only. Only Prime Staff or Prime Volunteers are allowed to bring food out in an official capacity.
